## WHAT IS AN ENDODONTIST?

An endodontist is a dentist with two or more years of intensive post-dental school specialty training. They specialize in root canal therapy, root canal retreatment and root canal surgery.

## WHAT IS A ROOT CANAL?

A root canal is a procedure designed to remove the dead or diseased pulp tissue from the inside of the tooth and replace it with a special filling material.

## HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE?

Most endodontic therapy can be completed in 1-2 visits. The number of visits and length of time depends upon your individual situation.

## WILL IT HURT?

With the most up-to-date techniques, local anesthetic to numb the tooth and analgesics (pain medication), root canal therapy is usually performed with minimal or no discomfort. In fact, a root canal is performed to remove dead, diseased or damaged pulp tissue thereby relieving pain. Nitrous Oxide sedation is not available.

## WHAT CAN I EXPECT AFTER MY ROOT CANAL?

During the first few days after treatment, it is normal for the tooth to be tender. This is because your body is working to heal the affected area. Try to avoid biting or chewing on a tender tooth during these first few days. If discomfort lasts more than a few days, please call our office.

## WHAT DO I NEED TO DO AFTER MY ROOT CANAL?

Once your root canal is completed, a temporary filling (restoration) is usually placed in your tooth. You may be advised to return to your dentist who will decide how best to complete the final restoration of your tooth to protect it from future fracture or decay.

## WHAT IS THE SUCCESS RATE OF A ROOT CANAL?

More than 90% of endodontically treated teeth are saved. Of course, getting a proper restoration following root canal treatment along with good oral hygiene and routine visits to your dentist all influence the prognosis. Unless there are other future complications (fractures, cavities, gum disease, etc.), root canal therapy should last a lifetime.

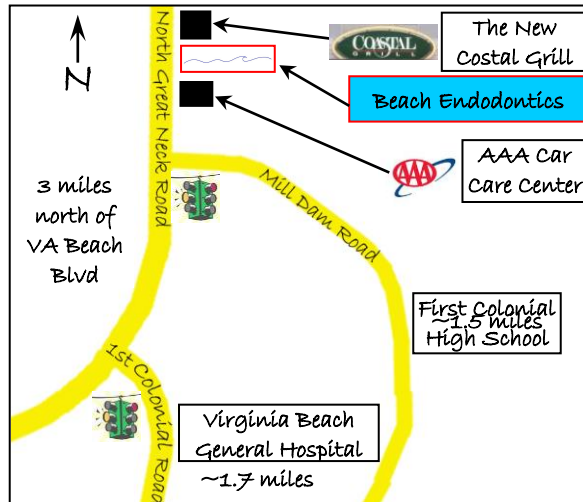
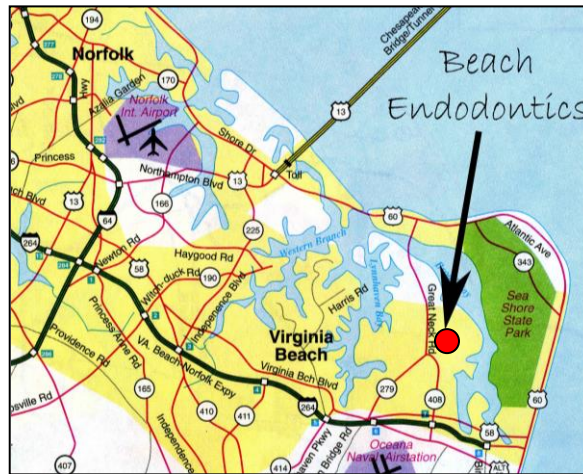
